\$ Work Study Funding \$

The Office of Graduate Studies has announced that all graduate Work-Study funds are now under the new program. This has resulted in a temporary reduction of funds to programs, but Ecology has received its official allocation for 1993-1994. The only stipulation from Graduate Studies is that a preference be given to PhD candidates. Within the program, GGE has authority to set other criteria.

Allocations of GGE shares will be based upon the service given to Ecology by the major professor of the applicant. If you have applied for Work-Study assistance through the Financial Aid office, please notify Ted, ASAP, that you wish to be considered by the program. The criteria of eligibility have been relaxed so more students qualify, however the application deadline has already passed.
